Day 1

SIBIU- BRUKENTHAL PALACE, Avrig

Arrival to Sibiu airport.

You will be picked up by English speaking driver.

Our first visit is town Sibiu (Hermannstadt in German) and there we are heading straight for Lunch or coffee break at restaurant Max-The Original erected in one of the oldest buildings of Sibiu, originally built in gothic style.

Then is a time for an excursion in Sibiu-founded in the 12th century by German settlers known as 'Transylvanian Saxons'.

Walking tour includes most important landmarks: Large Square, Brukenthal Museum, City Hall, Council Tower, Small Square, Pharmacy Museum, Liars Bridge, Huet Square, Brukenthal HighSchool, Orthodox Cathedral, Citadel Street and Thalia Hall.

Tour also includes the visit to Lutheran Cathedral (St. Mary's Evangelical Church)- built in 14th century and still bearing Gothic façade.

Dinner at Pardon Café with selections of Romanian wines, located next to the remaining fortifications of Sibiu. Cooking show with chef Marius Rafa.

Late in the evening we arrive to **Brukenthal Palace** in Avrig, built by Baron Samuel von Brukenthal, Governor of Transylvania (1777-1787). 3 overnights at hotel Brukenthal Palace in Avrig.









Day 2 BRUKENTHAL PALACE- BALEA LAKE- CARTA- BRUKENTHAL PALACE (ca 70 km)

After breakfast leaving for Romanians famous mountain road – Transfagarasan. From Balea Waterfall we are going by cable car to Balea Lac- glacier lake, situated at 2,034 m of altitude. We are having most pleasant walking to surrounded by peaks of Fagaras Mountains.

Our lunch will be served at the rustic restaurant of Balea Lake Chalet- sitting literally on the Balea Lake, and offering a great view from its terrace.

Then by cable car back to Balea Waterfall and depart for Carta.

We are visiting Carta Cistercian Monastery dated back from 13th century and the most Eastern monument the Cistercians built in Europe.

Return back to Brukenthal Palace. Free time.

Dinner will be served at the Orangery restaurant-historic café of Brukenthal Palace.







BRUKENTHAL PALACE- BRASOV- BRAN- BRUKENTHAL PALACE (ca km)

After breakfast we are going for whole day excursion.

First, we go to medieval town of Brasov.

During our sightseeing in Brasov we have a coffee break at cafés Inspiratio or La Vatra Ardealului. Then we continue to visit with city's most important sights: Town Hall square, Black Church, Weaver Bastion, White and Black Tower.

Then we drive to town Bran, 25 km from Brasov, mostly famous because of medieval Bran Castle. There will have a lunch at Bran Castle's restaurant, former Queen Marie's Tea House, built in the 1920s, where the Queen Marie of Romania introduced afternoon tea ritual to local elite. Then we visit a Bran Castle- real inspiration for Dracula's Castle, brimming with centuries-old history, myths and legends. We'll explore spooky hallways, towers, chambers and discover its history.

Early evening we return to Brukenthal Palace, you will have time to enjoy your last evening there.

Farewell dinner will be organized at historic café of Brukenthal Palace.







Day 4 BRUKENTHAL PALACE-SIBIU AIRPORT

Breakfast at hotel.

Transfer to Sibiu International airport according to departure times.
